
Expanding our borders: Indian medical missionaries take on new challenges.

Jesus said, "You will be witnesses to me in Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria and to the uttermost parts of the world". If the EHA hospitals are considered to be EHA's Jerusalem, then Judea would be the communities impacted through its community health and development projects. Samaria might refer to its ministry to those in India's society who are forgotten and marginalized - the mentally handicapped, the physically disabled, the aged, those who need palliative care and women and children who are subject to abuse and trafficking. EHA has been serving in other parts of the our world as well - in Albania during the Kosovo crisis and in Zimbabwe. Dr. Vinod Shah, veteran EHA missionary is now the International Executive Director of ICMDA (International Christian Medical dental Association) with a ministry that it truly international. The latest initiative is in South Sudan.

Drs. Anil and Shalini Cherian are long-term EHA missionaries. On a visit to South Sudan, Anil was moved by its dire needs. (See box: South Sudan...) Meanwhile, Shalini, at a conference in Norway heard of the same needs. They both independently and simultaneously heard God's call. To cut a long story short, they are being deputed by EHA to serve in S. Sudan for 5 years, beginning January 2014. Their main task will be training Sudanese health care workers.

Canadian interest in S. Sudan

The University of Calgary trained 11 Sudanese refugee doctors who returned to Africa in 2007. The Cherians, ICMDA, and the Sudanese government will work along with CIDA, Agri Teams and U of C to develop a Training Institute. Once the program is underway there will be opportunities for Canadian doctors, nurses and other professionals to participate. We will keep you informed.

- A land locked country in East Africa with about 8 million people.
- It was embroiled in war and conflict for many vears
- One of the poorest countries with little existing infrastructure
- Vast health needs 1 doctor for 500.000 people
- Highest maternal mortality 2 out of every 100 women die giving birth
- Out of 100 children, 13 die before the age of 5

INSTITUTE OF MEDICAL MISSIONS

One of EHA Canada's Initiatives was the establishment of the Institute for Medical missions (IMM). IMM was set up to train Indian medical students in missions. IMM has inspired students to join missions. This seminal work needs to expand. Other countries have asked for help in setting up similar organizations. Drs. Mathew and Latha George were long time missionaries at the Duncan Hospital in North Bihar. Mathew has taken on the challenge of expanding and directing IMM. Latha will run the "Saline Solution", training physicians in their witness to Christ.

CENTER FOR BIOETHICS

EHA is blazing a new trail - the Center for Bioethics (TCB), the first of its kind in India, started by Dr. Jamila George.

In partnership with LIFE International, TCB has translated and printed 'Life in the womb' brochures and Flip charts in Hindi. These are excellent tools to create awareness regarding sanctity of life. About 100 youth attended "Sanctity of life" seminars in Delhi. Pray that the center will be a source of salt and light thus influencing ethical standards in the medical profession in India.

PROJECT NeST

In April 2013, EHA-Canada provided a grant for NeST (Neonatal Education and Support Training). Its purpose is to reduce neonatal deaths and promote healthy babies. In the first year master trainers will be trained, who will then train other caregivers



AWARDS TO EHA HOSPITALS

RSBY is a government insurance scheme that provides subsidies to Indian citizens who fall below the poverty line. Government has been seeking the aid of NGO s to implement the scheme. EHA has been in the forefront of this venture. Two EHA hospitals were recently given awards for their service.

Harriet Benson Memorial Hospital, a unit of Emmanuel Hospital Association has been awarded for Appreciable Contribution in the 4th phase of RSBY, UP.

Herbertpur Christian Hospital has been selected for the RSBY Award For 'Outstanding Service To The Community - Private Hospital' at the ICICI Lombard & CNBC TV18 India Healthcare Awards 2012. This is a televised national award putting the spotlight on India's finest healthcare providers


